

ORDINANCE NO. 1364

THE CITY OF WOODLAND, WASHINGTON

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE WOODLAND SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM, AS TRANSMITTED TO DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY AND ADOPTED IN RESOLUTION 658 WITH AMENDMENTS AS PROVIDED BY DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY

WHEREAS, after completing a public process beginning in 2012 and running through 2015, the City Council passed a resolution on June 15, 2015 with Intent to the adopt an updated Shoreline Master Program and authorize transmittal to Department of Ecology for review; and

WHEREAS, the 2015 Shoreline Master Program was submitted to the Department of Ecology for review and approval pursuant to state law and regulation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology held their own 60 day public process ending in October 2015; and

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2016 the Department of Ecology issued a letter conditionally approving the City's submitted Shoreline Master Program subject to a list of required and recommended changes; and

WHEREAS, the required and recommended changes are minimal and meet the City's intent for the SMP; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to WAC 173-26-120 (7)(b)(i) the City Council finds acceptable and adopts the required and recommended Department of Ecology changes to the Shoreline Master Program, as shown in Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Adoption of Shoreline Master Program with revisions. The Shoreline Master Program, Exhibit B, together with revisions set forth by Department of Ecology as shown in Exhibit A are hereby adopted.


Section 2: Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase in this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 3: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall be transmitted to the Washington State Department of Ecology for review and approval. This ordinance shall become effective upon Ecology's written notice of final action.






**SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 1364
