Resolution No. 68 - 2015

A resolution of the Okanogan Board of County Commissioners announcing their intent to adopt a revised Shoreline Master Program and transmitting the Shoreline Master Program and supporting records to the Department of Ecology.

WHEREAS, RCW 90.58.080(2)(a)(v) establishes that on or before December 1, 2014, Okanogan County must develop or amend its shoreline master program in accordance with the provisions of the Shoreline Management Act; and

WHEREAS, the current Shoreline Master Program was adopted on July 7, 1987 and amended on May 20, 1996, and has not been revised since that date; and

WHEREAS, In December 2003 the Department of Ecology adopted new, revised Shoreline Master Program Guidelines (WAC 173-26); and

WHEREAS, Okanogan County entered into a grant contract with the Washington State Department of Ecology effective on July 1, 2005 to complete a Regional Shoreline Master Program in compliance with the Shoreline Management Act and, with consideration of the Shoreline Master Program Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, Environmental review was initiated early in the process with a Final Determination of Non-significance published on July 1, 2015, and

WHEREAS, All notices of all public hearings and public meetings regarding this matter have been published according to law.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed the Shoreline Master Program on February 23, 2015 and March 9, 2015 and has recommended the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners adopt the updated Shoreline Master Program.

WHEREAS, THE Board of County Commissioners made final adjustment in concert with comments by WDOE and staff and held final public hearings in June 2015. And is satisfied the content of the proposed Master Program serves the public interest of Okanogan County

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners intends to adopt the Regional Shoreline Master Program (attachment 3) following completion of required Department of Ecology review and subsequent public review process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the Findings of Fact (Attachment 1), Conclusions of Law (Attachment 2), and No Net Loss report (Attachment 4).
