As you know, Ecology approved the Yakima County Regional Shoreline Master Program comprehensive update for the City of Grandview with specific required changes on December 18, 2009. The City of Grandview (City) agreed to those changes in a letter received by Ecology on January 22, 2010. Per WAC 173-26-120(7)(b)(i) the effective date of the City of Grandview Shoreline Master Program is January 22, 2010.
