Project Location: The proposed 396-acre bank is 1.5 miles northeast of Mount Vernon in Skagit County, Washington, bounded by State Route (SR) 538 on the south, SR 9 and Babcock Road on the east, and Swan Road on the north.

Project Description: The proposed work will restore wetlands and streams for use as a wetland mitigation bank.
