

Collectors for the E-Cycle Washington Program

Funded by manufacturers, the E-Cycle Washington program provides responsible recycling of computers, monitors and TVs at no cost to citizens, small businesses and other entities in the State of Washington.

E-Cycle Washington collectors:

- Are licensed to do business in Washington State
- Register online with the Department of Ecology at <http://www.ecy.wa.gov/programs/swfa/eproductrecycle/collector.html>
- Get paid for accepting computers, monitors and TVs from the public
- Operate a staffed collection site with defined hours of operation
- Store the electronics collected indoors on wooden pallets
- Agree to basic handling and shipping requirements (see details about being a collector at <http://www.wmmfa.net/> "Collectors" link)
- No-cost shipping from collector location to a processor is provided by the WA Materials Management & Financing Authority
