### **Coming from Seattle (West heading East)**

- From I-90, take **Exit 106**
- Continue on to 4-way stop sign (Pilot, Perkins, I-90 Inn at 4-way stop sign)
- At 4-way stop go straight (Cascade Way)
- Follow road into town. (Cascade Way turns into University Way)
- Continue straight on University Way following fairgrounds signs
- Turn right on Chestnut Street (3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> stop light)
- Go one (1) block and turn left onto 7<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Go approximately one (1) block (You will see paved lot on right at the end of the road)
- Turn Right and go through lot heading towards Gazebo.
- Turn Left in front of Gazebo (Watch for signs) and go past yellow buildings
- The Heritage Center is the third door on the left facing Red Grandstands

### **Coming from Yakima/Spokane**

- From I-90, take **Exit 109**
- At stop sign turn Right onto Canyon Road (Bar 14 restaurant on the right)
- Follow Canyon road to second light (Mountain View)
- Turn right on Mountain View
- Continue on to second stop light (Chestnut Street)
- Turn left on Chestnut Street
- Continue on Chestnut to 7<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Turn Right on 7<sup>th</sup> Ave
- Go approximately one (1) block (You will see paved lot on right at the end of the road)
- Turn Right and go through lot heading towards Gazebo.
- Turn Left in front of Gazebo (Watch for signs) and go past yellow buildings
