- Continue North on Main Street to the light at 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue.
- Turn right (East) on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. Go three blocks to Ruby Street.
- Turn right.
- We are at 209 North Ruby Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenues.
