- Drive south on I-5.
- Take the Martin Way exit (#109).

- At the third traffic light, turn right onto Desmond Drive.
- Once on Desmond Drive, head uphill and at the intersection turn left.
- Proceed along the front of the Ecology building.
- Proceed past a stop sign at the main entrance and find the visitors parking lot on the left.
- There will be a sign-in table near the main reception desk.

(From Vancouver to Lacey)

- Drive north on I-5.
- Take the Martin Way exit (#109).
- At the stop light on the off ramp, turn right onto Martin Way.

- Once on Desmond Drive, head uphill and at the intersection turn left.
- Proceed along the front of the Ecology building.

(From Spokane to Moses Lake)

- Drive west on I-90.
- Take the WA-17 exit- EXIT 179 - toward Othello/Moses Lake/Ephrata.
- At the stop sign on the off ramp, turn right.
- Turn right onto Hwy 17.
- Continue on Hwy 17 turning right onto Patton Blvd.
- Follow Patton Blvd. toward the Grant County Airport.
- Turn left onto Randolph Road or Bolling St. to access campus parking areas.

(From Seattle to Moses Lake)

- Driving east on I -90.
- Take EXIT 179 - toward Othello/Moses Lake/Ephrata.
- At the stop sign on the off ramp, turn left.
- Turn right onto Hwy 17.
- Continue on Hwy 17 turning right onto Patton Blvd.
- Follow Patton Blvd. toward the Grant County Airport.
- Turn left onto Randolph Road or Bolling St. to access campus parking areas.
