


Current Status of National Program

Demonstration Project was:

- Scheduled for MN in 2008
- Would then roll out to WA, OR, and Vermont in 2009

Adjusting WA Recovery Rates

- Adjusted Recovery Rates reduce the Raw Recovery Rate by 10% to 20%
- Adjusted Recovery Rate Range for WA State in 2007 = 46% to 52%
- Adjusted Recovery Rates were determined for each county as well


Why?

Why was WA Raw Recovery Rate reduced 10% to 20%?

- WA State Annual Reports do not have a category for paint related materials
- Some facilities include paint related materials with their oil base paint numbers
- Some facilities include paint related materials in other, non-paint, reported numbers

Washington State Leftover Paint

20% Adjusted Recovery Rate by County



Statewide 20% Adjusted Recovery Rate = 46%

0 – 25 Percent Adjusted Recovery Rate (red and blue lined counties only accept oil base paints)
 26 – 50 Percent Adjusted Recovery Rate
 51 – 75 Percent Adjusted Recovery Rate
 76 – 100+ Percent Adjusted Recovery Rate
 Unknown
