

### **Directions to Tacoma Public Utilities Bldg and Auditorium 3628 So. 35<sup>th</sup> St. Tacoma, WA. 98409**

FYI - Traffic can be bad at the Hwy 16 and I-5 interchange-give yourself plenty of time to make up for possible traffic back-ups. Hopefully, this can be mitigated by the 10 a.m. start.

From I-5 take the Hwy 16 Exit heading West to Bremerton, From Hwy 16 take the Union Ave. Exit, and at the light take a left onto Union Avenue (heading South). After going through the light at Center St., continue down the hill to South 35<sup>th</sup> St. Turn Rt. on South 35<sup>th</sup> and enter either one of the parking lots which are directly across from or in front of the TPU building. Please do **not** use the assigned parking spaces.

Enter the building going up the stairs off of So. 35<sup>th</sup> St. The auditorium is down one floor and on the right side of the hallway. Signs will be posted.
