

**WAC 197-11-970 Determination of nonsignificance (DNS).**

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Ecology is proposing to add two hazardous organic constituents to Appendix III of WAC 173-351- 990: 2,3,7,8-Tetrachlorodibenzo- p-dioxin - [CAS 1746-01-6] and *alpha, alpha-Dimethylphenethylamine* [CAS 122-09-8]. This revision is necessary to be consistent with federal rules in 40 CFR Part 258.

Proponent: Washington State Department of Ecology

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The rule affects municipal solid waste landfills operating in areas under the jurisdiction of the Department of Ecology and local jurisdictional health authorities.

Lead agency: Washington State Department of Ecology

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
