DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal Adopt revisions to Chapter 173-350 WAC – Solid Waste Handling Standards. Revisions address the operation of compost and anaerobic/aerobic digestion facilities, including exemptions to permitting for qualifying facilities.

Proponent Washington State Department of Ecology

Location of proposal, including street address, if any Rule will be applicable statewide in areas under the jurisdiction of local health authorities and the Department of Ecology.

Lead agency Washington State Department of Ecology

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.
