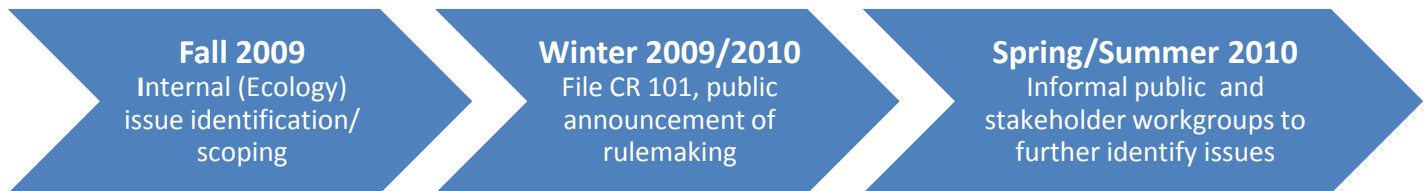


Objective: Revise chapter WAC 173-350 in its entirety with emphasis on clarifying organics and soil issues.

Approach: Throughout 2009 – 2010 we will be in the preliminary planning phase of rulemaking. **Stakeholders and the public will be contacted in the Spring of 2010.** Kathi Scanlan will work with Ecology technical leads who are responsible for specific topics, content, and stakeholder workgroups. SWAC will be informed and/or consulted at rule milestones.

Rule Timeline: 2009 – 2012, 2 - 3 year project
Year 1: Internal Ecology planning/issue identification
Year 2 (possible Year 3): Public involvement / draft & finalize rule
