Title of rule and other identifying information: The Department of Ecology (Ecology) proposes to adopt amendments to certain portions of the Sediment Management Standards (SMS) Regulations, chapter 173-204 Washington Administrative Code (WAC). This rule defines the requirements for managing contaminated sediments in Washington.

Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: The purpose of this rule proposal is to implement changes to the state's Sediment Management Standards for cleanup of contaminated sediment sites to clarify requirements to protect human health and the environment. The amendments proposed include:

- Integrating requirements for sediment cleanup actions in the SMS rule with requirements in the Model Toxics Control Act Cleanup Regulation (WAC 173-340).
- Updating the SMS cleanup decision framework to address bioaccumulative chemicals.
- Proposing chemical and biological benthic criteria for freshwater sediments.
- Clarifying requirements for coordinating cleanup actions and source control measures.

Reasons supporting proposal: The current SMS rule does not include clear and implementable requirements for cleaning up sediment contaminated with bioaccumulative chemicals that pose a risk to both human health and the environment and freshwater sediment sites. These types of contaminated sediments is complicated by uncertainties about protecting human health, the timing and feasibility of source control, how to incorporate background levels of contamination, and liability associated with historical releases. The lack of clear rule requirements has caused lengthy cleanup delays, inefficient use of available cleanup funds which can result in continued exposure to unhealthy levels of hazardous substances. Rule revisions are needed to provide clear, implementable, and predictable requirements for sediment cleanup actions to make the cleanup of contaminated sediments more efficient, effective, and protective.
