The following comments were received during the February 7th to March 9th public comment period for the Most Western Laundry site. These comments will be added to the site file and made publicly available.

Comment 1: Mr. Ralph Larson, Teel Building Partnership, Aberdeen - Please remove my name from the mailing list and any 1605 Simpson properties, including any Grays Harbor restaurants.

Response: Properties were removed from the mailing list for all future notifications regarding the Most Western Laundry site.

Comment 2: Mr. Jack Root of Hoquiam called to say that he was involved with removing the above ground materials left over after the fire at Most Western Laundry. During this work they found where the boiler was located. Roglins (Evergreen) was then hired to remove the asbestos that was in the soil around the boiler. Mr. Root did not do any excavation but rather hauled the burned debris to the Roglins Landfill on the Westport Highway.
