Subject: Comments on Ecology's proposed Section 303(d) listing for impaired waters

By this communication Kaiser Aluminum & Chemical Corporation submits comments to Ecology's proposed 2002/2004 Section 303(d) list of impaired waters for the State of Washington. We understand that this is the first 303(d) list that Ecology has proposed to submit to EPA Region 10 since the 1998 list was submitted and approved. This new list, if approved by EPA, will supercede and replace the 1998 list, which is in effect now. Kaiser believes that in developing the 303D listing for DO in the Spokane River that Ecology has not followed appropriate procedure. The details describing Ecology's failure to follow procedure, utilize appropriate data and the implications are described in the attached comments provided by the City of Spokane and the City of Coeur d'Alene. Kaiser believes the issues raised in those letters are appropriate and incorporates them by reference as Kaiser comments.

As such Kaiser believes that Ecology has not appropriately developed the proposed 2002/2004 303(d) list for the Spokane River and Long Lake Reservoir.
