Dear Sir,

1. In looking at the "revised" data I question why Capitol Lake and Capitol Lake(Southern basin) has not been updated. Data listed shows these lake sections as a "5" for bacteria and Total phosphorus. Thurston County Health Dept's testing program says it has met the water quality standard for the past 10+ years. Their test include specifically looking at bacteria.
2. The Lake has always been high in phosphorus. Has the underlying natural conditions been changed in order to list Capitol Lake as a category "5" for phosphorus?
3. The pH listing is new. Since 2010 ninety percent of the samples have met the standard. But the new listing is only using testing results up to 2010. If you are going to update the listing why not use the most recent data available?
