A few problems I have noted.

From a listing page, clicking the "back" button doesn't work, and forces the user to start over.

Trying to submit a comment on a listing doesn't work. I tried several times and it does not send and it deletes the site ID from the entry.

I clicked on the red square in Lake Ozette and it told me it was Coal Creek. Later I got to the Lake Ozette site, and provided me with appropriate information.

Probably need a category 5M for mercury. Lake Ozette gets a category 5 for mercury in tissue, and it isn't going to be associated with Washington State human inputs. I'm not saying global sources are natural, but a TMDL here would be futile. Need category 5M and default to Mercury CAP as only action feasible. Since Mercury CAP is in place, then make this site a Category 4 of some type.

As the site currently works, I cannot use it in a short class on water quality, because I'd mainly be stumbling around with problems.
