Comment of the Draft Washington Industrial Stormwater General Permit.

Section S3-Employee Training- This section requires the Permittee to attend Ecology sponsored training within one year of obtaining coverage under the permit. At the public meetings in both Centralia and Spokane, Ecology indicated that a "key employee" of each permit holder must attend the training. It is unclear if the "Permittee" who attends the training must work at the permitted facility or if it can be a representative of a company's corporate staff.

We strongly encourage Ecology to allow companies' corporate staff to attend training sessions and be responsible for training key employees at individual permitted facilities. This will allow the training received at the permitted facility to focus on site-specific stormwater issues, in addition to communicating information included in Ecology's training classes. Ecology's classes will be generic as they will be training to a variety of industries.
