Fruit Packers	163	\$ 547,584	Fees based on one of three fee categories depending on permitted operations. Noncontact Cooling Water With Additives and Noncontact Cooling Water Without Additives are flow based subcategories. Fees range from \$496 to \$19,801. Packing, storage, drenching operations have fees based on number of bins processed/stored. Fees range from \$197 to \$11,885.
