Jonathan,

I read the proposal to line lagoons and believe this to be very very expensive. I understand the need to line lagoons that leak but this represents only a small portion of lagoons statewide. I believe this would put a lot of dairymen out of business if made mandatory. I think setbacks for manure application on open ground/corn ground are necessary to prevent runoff. My ground is shallow and filled with clay and hardpan glacial till from Mt. Rainier and would be difficult to test 3 feet down. I think programs should be targeted toward improving management skills of polluters/offenders and not those that are doing a good job. Some of the environmental groups have legitimate arguments while others peck the nuisance side of the issue (smells, dusts, flies...). I believe there is a lot to lose in terms of agriculture if liners are necessary on all farms. Please consider change in moderation; I believe this is the better way.
