

## STATEMENT OF BASIS

### CENTENNIAL TANK CLEANING, INC. STATE PERMIT NO. ST-9125

The purpose of this Statement of Basis is to explain the need to modify the Permit to change the Non-polar Materials (HEM) limits and monitoring frequency.

#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

#### II. REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION

Centennial Tank Cleaning, Inc. submitted on September 25, 2008, a request for permit modification to change HEM limits and monitoring frequency. The HEM limits were lower than necessary for discharge to the Port of Sunnyside IWWTF.

The following modifications have been made to the permit:

- Changes to S1.B.1. Numerical Limitations (page 6).
  - Addition of an Average Monthly column to the table
  - Non-polar Materials (HEM) daily maximum limit changed to 100 mg/L (from 26 mg/L)
  - Addition of Non-Polar Materials (HEM) Average Monthly limit of 60 mg/L (new limit)
- Changes to S2.A. Wastewater Monitoring table (page 7).
  - Change sampling frequency of HEM to 2/month<sup>d</sup> (from 1/month<sup>e</sup>) (change footnote from "e" to "d")
  - Delete Footnote "e" from table (page 8)
- Change the authorized Ecology signature on permit cover page to Robert F. Barwin, Acting Section Manager.

This Statement of Basis explains the modification of the Permit.
