I just returned from traveling and simply want to state re both the registration of imazamox and the permitting for shrimp control, that I am hereby joining every comment that was in opposition to both of these actions that are proposed to be taken. I think that these actions will only exacerbate the already hazardous condition of the bay, and the unknown consequences to the nearby ocean waters. Just a reminder that in a lawsuit that I was involved with that was dismissed a year ago, the Attorney General's defending the spraying of imazapyr and glyphosate for spartina eradication, described willapa bay as a toxic soup, implying that there was no way that anything in willapa bay could be pesticide free. Its time to not add more toxicity, but to begin to allow nature to heal the bay. I hope that my objections to the registration of imzamox and the permitting for shrimp control will be accepted.
