Dear Mr. Jennings:

I am writing to notify you of our intended lake rehabilitations for this fall, October 2014, and of our compliance with our National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. WA0041009.

The lakes and locations for this year's proposed rehabilitations are as follows:

Stevens County: McDowell Lake – 11.5 miles southeast of Colville: Township 34 North, Range 41 East Willamette Meridian (WM), Sections 6, 7 and 8. It is 47 acres in surface area.

Grant County: Sago, Hourglass, Widgeon and Hampton Chain of Lakes – 8 miles north of Othello: Township 17 North, Range 29 East WM, Sections 19, 30 and 31. The combined total surface acreage is about 132 acres (Sago = 1.5, Hourglass = 2, Widgeon = 10.8, Upper Hampton = 68, Lower Hampton = 20, Hampton Slough = 15, Marie = 3, Para-Juvenile = 12).

As per requirements of the NPDES permit, each lake will be sampled per section S2, page 6 of the permit. Those measured parameters will include:


- pH
- Temperature
- Zooplankton
- Trout Bioassay
- VOCs, semi-VOCs, and for any other inert ingredients listed on the MSDS for the liquid rotenone product used (all at an accredited lab, as per approved EPA methods).

There will be no neutralization of outflow waters with potassium permanganate, so we will not need samples monitoring that activity.
