To whom it may concern:

This letter is concerning the mosquito control permit changes that affect the nuisance adulticiding (fogging). I think the mosquitoes should be controlled in our area but with less Toxic adulticides. There are currently two adulticiding sprays the CMCD are using for adulticiding one of which is synthetic and more Toxic to our environment and to us people. The less harmful/toxic adulticide chemical they are currently using is an insecticide **Pyroicide** which is less harmful and more natural and does almost no harm, and is an effective adulticide spray to battle mosquitoes. I think the more unnatural and Toxic adulticides should be banned and only the natural and less Toxic adulticiding sprays should be encouraged and used in our neighborhoods, or we can battle the mosquitoes ourselves. So if natural less Toxic adulticides are to be used I see no harm in using them closer that 300 feet around lakes and or the state's water to battle the mosquito problems in our area.
