Several years ago our neighbors daughter (3 months old at the time) became ill with sleeping illness (encephalitis). She remained mentally at that stage but her body developed. She passed away at the age of 21.

Our horse became ill with encephalitis. We practically had to hand feed her and she had to be cooled down under a sprinkler for weeks.

Now we also have to contend with the West Nile Virus.

The danger of spraying the live mosquitoes by far outweighs the danger of exposing humans and animals to this dreadful decease.

We certainly hope that people in charge of this problem will acquire the knowledge to what they would be exposing the population of Washington State with without spraying the mosquitoes.

We have learned about preventive medicine. Spraying the mosquitoes is in our mind preventive medicine.
