As a resident of Kennewick, WA, I am strongly opposed to the new permit implications. We live here to enjoy our backyard and the outdoor activities this area has to offer. Not allowing the Mosquito Control District to properly fog and control mosquitoes will significantly impact our quality of life. I support our local Mosquito Control District. Excessive mosquitoes will impact our health, our quality of life, my choice to use parks, recreation and will have an economic impact on our community resulting from visitors not wanting to spend time in mosquito-infested areas. Also as a taxpayer, I would like you to take these comments into account:

1. Do not separate nuisance and vector mosquitoes, both need to be controlled.
2. Eliminate the use of the term "waters of the state".
3. Change the current language to allow organized mosquito control districts under Chapter 17.28 RCW to adulticide to control vector and nuisance mosquitoes as listed in the district's Integrated Pest Management Plan.
4. Eliminate Malathion and Nalid restrictions from the permit.
