My concern pertains directly to your radical attempt to implement massive retrictions, IE. use permit, to our current mosquito control districts. Several things must be changed in the proposed wording of this new permit, and below are just a few reasons examples of such.

- 1). Do not seperate nuisance and vector mosquitos, both need to be controlled.
- 2). Eliminate the use of the term "waters of the state"
- 3). Change proposed language to allow organized mosquito control districts under RCW chapter 17.28 to aduaticide to control vector and nuisance mosquitos as listed in the districts integrated pest management plan.
- 4). Eliminate Malathion and Nalid restrictions from this permit.

Again, the above mentioned concerns, if implemented, would basically render our mosquito control useless, thus endangering lives in the community. You of all people should understand that mosquitos live and regenerate in water. So, how do you expect their populations to be controlled if you implement "waters of the state" as a protected area. Our community is surrounded on three sides by state waterways, not including several game refuges. Hopefully, you now understand how ridiculous these proposed restrictions are, if not, you're Democratic constituants soon will, by way of being voted out of office.
