I am writing in response to a meeting that was held in Moses Lake a few weeks ago regarding mosquito spraying. You have got to be kidding when you are suggesting to limit the spraying in Moses Lake for Mosquito's. Lake Wenatchee in Leavenworth tried this a few years ago and everything stopped. Tourism, especially was affected by this insane move. The possibility of West Nile infections to towns people and school children, with a school located about 100 yards from the lake, is a reality . I have spoken to people that were here before the spraying started and they have said it was unbearable to step outside. We are a struggling community , like other communities our size, this would definitely kill our tourism and posibbably turn Moses Lake into a ghost town.
