I would like to communicate that I have the following issues with respect to the proposed changes being forced upon the Columbia Mosquito Control District and I would like to see some of the wording and restrictions changed.

1. Do not separate nuisance and vector mosquitoes, both need to be controlled.
2. Eliminate the use of the term "waters of the state".
3. Change the current language to allow organized mosquito control districts under chapter 17.28 RCW to adulticide to control vector and nuisance mosquitoes as listed in the districts Integrated Pest Management Plan.
4. Eliminate Malathion and Nalid restrictions from the permit.
5. Allow CMCD to control mosquito populations in public parks, recreations areas, along recreational waterways. Excessive mosquitoes will impact the health, quality of life, use of parks, recreation and an economic impact on our community.
