Dear Sir;

I'm writing in regard to the language in this permit. Please do not seperate nuisance and vector mosquitoes, we have to control both. Remove the term "Waters of the State". Change the language to allow Mosquito districts to use aduaticide to control both nuisance and vector mosquitoes under chapter 17.28 RCW. Both Malathion and Nalid should be allowed since they work well.

I live next to the McNary Wildlife Refuge. The refuge has a massive amount of still water that provides ideal conditions for mosquito rearing. It is a bird sanctuary, so all the elements are there for a west Nile virus outbreak. Without serious mosquito control measures, people could not live in this area, and people were living here before the refuge was established.
