It has been brought to my attention that some new action is about to be taken to remove part of the measures that keep our mosquito's in control, if even somewhat. I have a beautiful deck, that would be a joy to sit out at in the evening, or early morning hours, but the mosquito's in our area are so out of control, that it is impossible to do so. To remove any part of what is already not enough, would be unbearable to the residents in this area.

Please do not separate nuisance and vector mosquitoes, both need to be controlled

Please eliminate the use of the term "waters of the state"

Please change the current language to allow organized mosquito control districts under chapter 17.28 RCW to adulticide to control vector and nuisance mosquitoes as listed in the districts integrated Pest Management Plan.

Please eliminate Malathion and Nalid restrictions from the permit.

Please know that we SUPPORT mosquito control districts. Having excessive mosquitoes will impact our health, quality of life, use of parks, recreation and have a negative impact of our community.
