Dear Mr. Jennings,

Regarding the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits.

It has come to my attention that my mosquito district will not be able to apply pesticide for adult mosquitoes as the new permit is currently written. Please reconsider and alter the permit to read: "The Permittee is authorized to discharge incidental amounts of adulticides and their residues to waters of the state for nuisance and vector mosquito control."

() Last year was the worst spring We ever seen mosquito-wise. We suspect with the wet winter/spring it will be as bad or worst. Now We can put up with mosquitoes that come out after dark by applying spray or lotion to myself or staying inside, but last year they were biting all day long till the mosquito district brought out the heavy artillery (airplane) and dispensed them. In my location that one application knocked them down and kept them there.
