

NPDES WAG-993000 requires that the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) submit an annual monitoring plan to the Washington State Department of Ecology (WSDOE).

Pending the results of sediment sampling conducted for the 2010 field season, WSDA plans, in concurrence with WSDOE, to collect no monitoring samples in 2011. If pending sediment sample results warrant further investigation, WSDA will cooperatively develop an amended sampling plan with WSDOE for 2011.
