Integrated Pest Management implies that a number of approaches be considered singly or in combination pests. Apparently only one technique (pesticide) has been considered in this and all previous permits. It has been stated in previous documents related to this permit that burrowing shrimp, unique in the animal kingdom, have no natural parasites or diseases that would allow biological control.

In a conference called by the permittee shortly after the initial permit in this series, Mr. Dewey of Taylor Shellfish did a presentation showing photographic projections of a trial of a roller that worked. What happened to this effort? Has any effort been made to find a method of compaction to mechanically control burrowing shrimp?

No reply necessary. This is an impressive document.
