Hi Derek,

The account below was written after Carbaryl exposure in April, 2001, and there is reference to Copper Hydroxide poisoning from April of 2000. Carbaryl (the product Sevin) was used by the nearest grower (150 feet at most from where we slept) in Sonoma wine country. Please feel free to use this account in your organizing.

When we went into Brentwood before the planned pesticide applications we shared tox profiles of Imidacloprid and Carbaryl, both used as part of the state-based Glassy-winged Sharpshooter pesticide program, and when we went back in after applications. Imidacloprid is used as a standard in every of the California state programs I've researched over the years.
