To Irrigation System Aquatic Weed and Aquatic Nuisance Plant and Algae Permittees

Permit Modification for Permit No. WAG-993000, Aquatic Nuisance Plant and Algae Control NPDES General Permit; and Permit No. WAG-991000, Irrigation System Aquatic Weed Control NPDES General Permit regarding the Conditions for use of GreenClean.

The above referenced permits have been modified to include the algaecide GreenClean. GreenClean is a peroxygen-based granular algaecide for the treatment and prevention of algae in ponds, streams, irrigation systems, ornamental pools, and fountains. It is authorized for use in aquatic environments in Washington State to control algae subject to all Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) label requirements and the following conditions:

1. Treatment with GreenClean is restricted to lakes, ponds, and irrigation systems across the state. Surrounding shorelands and wetlands will not be permitted for treatment.
2. The general permit allows for GreenClean use in areas where listed or threatened species may live or migrate through. The application requires that the applicant consult with WDFW or USF&W before making application to sites containing listed species.
3. GreenClean will only be applied to waters where algae are present.
4. Areas being treated with GreenClean will be closed to recreational activities during and for two hours after treatment applications. A recreational advisory must be posted by the applicator prior to treatment.
