SIDIR will provide two separate but connected types of information:

- A library of **Methods and Resources** for IDDE and source control to help local governments use the most effective strategies and actions for reducing stormwater pollution.
- Analysis the **Results and Findings** of IDDE and source control programs to identify common stormwater problems that could be supported or better addressed by regional efforts such as education, training, new BMPs, additional regulation, product replacement initiatives, legacy pollutant removal, improved source tracing tools, etc.
