### **Draft strategy document to be released for public review next month**

The Stormwater Work Group plans to release a draft stormwater monitoring and assessment strategy for public review on Wednesday, Nov. 4. The various stakeholders who comprise the Stormwater Work Group have been meeting since October 2008 to prioritize objectives for monitoring stormwater and to develop the draft strategy document, which will provide needed information about stormwater impacts to beneficial uses and evaluate the effectiveness of management actions in Puget Sound. In summary, this effort is focused on creating a better system to test stormwater and share results in a way that helps us make better decisions.

### **June 2010 deadline driving strategy development process**

The Stormwater Work Group is focused on developing a stormwater monitoring and assessment strategy by June 2010. The Department of Ecology established the deadline so that the document could be used in developing the monitoring requirements to be included in the next round of municipal stormwater NPDES permits. The timeline for this effort also helps meet the Puget Sound Partnership's mandate to develop an ecosystem monitoring program and falls within state budget process deadlines.
