I want the State to maintain our current cancer risk of one in a million, rather than weakening that protection and accepting a risk of 1 in 100,000.

Also, I want the State to increase the fish consumption rate used in calculations to set toxin levels. This level should be based on accurate information, and it is well known that the current consumption rates used are far too low.
