



How to apply/reapply for the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Industrial Stormwater General Permit

Reapply for Industrial Stormwater General Permit coverage using our new online application. Access it through Washington's secure gateway to many government services, SecureAccess Washington.

Follow the steps below:

1. Sign up for a SecureAccess Washington (SAW) account
(If you already have a SAW account, go to Step 2)
 - Go to: <https://secureaccess.wa.gov/ecy/wqwebportal/> (Shortcut: enter "secure access" into your search engine).
 - Complete the six-part sign-up sequence by creating a new account.
 - Enter your information including your name and email address.
 - You will receive an email confirmation. Click the link in the email.

2. Add service for WQWebPortal
 - Login to your SecureAccess Washington Account.
 - Under "Add a new Service," click on Department of Ecology.
 - Look for "Water Quality Permitting Portal (WQWebPortal)" and click "Apply" in the left column.

3. Under the My Services tab
 - Click the Water Quality Permitting Portal (WQWebPortal).
 - Click the "Permit Coverage-Notice of Intent (NOI)" link on the portal home page.
 - Select "Renew" for an Industrial Stormwater General Permit.

4. Fill out the entire application

5. Sign your application
 - If you already have a signature on file, and cannot access the electronic signature box, please call the number below.
 - Using the option "Print and Sign" for your signature.
 - Sign the form and return to the address on the signature page.
