Please accept these comments on the Washington State Department of Natural Resources (DNR) regarding the *Industrial Stormwater General NPDES Permit (ISGP)*. DNR is the manager of over three million acres of state trust lands comprised of forest, range, commercial and agricultural lands and 2.6 million acres of state-owned aquatic lands. DNR is committed to sustainably managing the state's resources, relying on sound science, and making transparent decisions in the public's interest throughout the environmental review process.

DNR strongly supports the additions to language in section S6.C. Additional Sampling Requirements and Effluent Limits for Discharges to Certain Impaired Waterbodies and Puget Sound Sediment Cleanup Sites. DNR believes that these additional sampling requirements are essential to maintaining the integrity of cleanup sites and impaired waterways.
