WWA Phase II	S5C4	32	Ecology should consider a financial ceiling either for combined or specific categories. Example where costs could get prohibitive is collection and analysis of benthic macroinvertebrate data that exceeds the local expertise.
WWA Phase II	S5C4	33	If a local jurisdiction has already done modeling the lead agency should utilize that data if at all possible, or use it as a calibration tool. Jurisdictions expected to pay a pro rat share should be included as a member of the integration team along with Ecology, and have opportunity to establish a consensus based strategy. Before investment is made we should confirm we are tackling the right problems where we can have an impact. People not familiar with the local conditions may seek unnecessary
