The City of Spokane appreciates the opportunity to comment informally on Ecology's proposed LID and MONITORING elements in the next Eastern Washington Phase Two Stormwater Permit.

LID – The City supports advancing LID generally as outlined, including a Stakeholder Process re: LID applicability within the regions of Eastern Washington. We conceptually support the 95th percentile retention criteria currently proposed by EPA, subject to applicability for our climate and facilities.

MONITORING – With over 100 MS4 outfalls, existing and anticipated TMDLs, and third-party attention on compliance with water quality standards, the City anticipates conducting its own analyses and is opposed to paying into a broad default monitoring program conducted by Ecology.
