From Taylor Shellfish, our perspective is that we need to be moving more and more towards LID practices. Technology and knowledge is evolving rapidly in this arena. It is not appropriate everywhere but where it is and to the extent we can incentivize the adoption of the practices rather than mandate them we think that is appropriate. Adjacent to sensitive areas (such as shellfish growing areas) similar to what we have done with O&M requirements on septic systems, we may need to consider more stringent stormwater regulations or requiring LID.
