

Workshop Description

This is a one-day class to train local government staff who are adopting the 2005 *Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington* (SWMMWW).

The Workshop will:

- Emphasize how to review Stormwater Site Plans (SSP) for proposed new development and redevelopment projects.
- Provide an overview of the relevant Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit requirements.
- Explain how to use the 2005 Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington to review a Stormwater Site Plan for consistency with Minimum Requirements such as source controls, on-site management, treatment and flow control.
- Use two case studies to explain the details associated with reviewing a SSP.
- Provide tips about how to review a Construction Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (CSWPPP).

Please note that this class will **not** cover:

- Phase I equivalent programs or manuals
- Low Impact Development Technical Guidance Manual for Puget Sound
- Eastern Washington Stormwater Management Manual
- Western Washington Hydrologic Model (WWHM) or related models
