



Upstream Priorities for Salmonid Habitat Improvement

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- 1st: reduce fine sediment in spawning gravel
- 2nd: cool water temperature and increase DO
 - Improved riparian cover alone will not achieve temperature standard
 - Other actions also necessary including improving channel morphology and increasing streamflow
- Channel improvement will reduce fine sediment in spawning gravel too
- Focus first on losing reach between Mitchell Creek and Lake Lawrence
