Due to scheduling difficulties, Ecology will complete its most recent round of consultation meetings with Full Group members later than was previously anticipated. Therefore, the draft Managed Implementation Plan comment deadline will be **extended to Friday, March 3.**

Ecology is asking Collaboration participants to comment on the draft Managed Implementation Plan (MIP) presented at the January 25 Full Group meeting. As discussed at that meeting, Ecology is interested in any feedback regarding specific language in the MIP that could benefit from greater clarity, as well as sections that may contain too much detail, or not enough detail. Comments should reference page numbers/outline sections and the related pieces of language within the MIP. Ecology is not expecting redline versions of the document.
