RE: Samra Farms LLC Request for a one year extension of Trust Water Donation Numbers CG4-23992(B)C and CG4-23992(C)C.

Dear Sir or Madam:

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge your request to extend and modify the above referenced trust water donations for the 2015 irrigation season.

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) pursuant to Chapter 90.42.080(1)b accepts your request to lengthen the term of Trust Water Donations CG4-23992(B)C and CG4-23992(C)C to include the 2015 irrigation season and to change the donated quantities to those listed below.

Portion of CG4-23992(B)C donated in 2015:

503.6 acre-feet of water to be used for the purpose of ground water preservation. This quantity is the result of fallowing 97.4 acres and a shortened irrigation season for the remaining 75 irrigated acres within the place of use in Okanogan County.

Portion of CG4-23992(C)C donated in 2015:

349 acre-feet of water to be used for the purpose of groundwater preservation. This quantity is the result of fallowing 40 acres and a shortened irrigation season for the remaining 124 irrigated acres within the place of use in Okanogan County.

The new expiration date for Trust Water Donations CG4-23992(B)C and CG4-23992(C)C is March 31, 2016.

Please keep in mind that under Chapter 90.42.080(4) RCW the total of any portion of the water right remaining with the donor plus the donated portion of the water right may not exceed the extent to which the water right was exercised during the five years before the original donation.

If, prior to expiration of these temporary donations, you would like to extend the donations once again, please send us a written request. Also, if you wish to modify any terms of your donation(s), your letter must include the new terms. Ecology will review your request and any new or modified terms and conditions and will notify you whether the donation(s) can be extended or terminated.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
