STIPULATION RE: WATER
USE FOR FIRE SUPPRESSION

It is hereby stipulated by all parties in the above-entitled cause as follows:

1. For purposes of this stipulation, fire suppression is defined as the act of extinguishing a fire, or protecting property in the vicinity of a fire, which poses an imminent threat to safety or property.
2. Use of water for fire suppression is a recognized emergency use and does not require a water right.
